ONLY parents / carers of Y3 and Y4 children are invited to attend.

Please do not send book bags that day for children in Y3 and Y4.** If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like a school packed lunch, please let school know the week before.

Parents of Y3 / 4 children can take their children home after the service.

Please can ALL Y3 and Y4 parents / carers complete the survey on the Website stating if

- You are taking your child home directly from church (please also name any siblings)
- Your child is walking back to school with class teachers

This is important as it makes the handover of children at the end of the service much smoother and safer. If Y3 and 4 siblings are being picked up directly from church, then please DO NOT SEND BOOK BAGS for these children and please send packed lunch in a disposable bag that day. This just means that those children do not need to carry anything to church.
