#### **YEAR 3 and 4 PARENTS INFORMATION**

ONLY parents / carers of Y3 and Y4 children are invited to attend.

We will allow Y5 and Y6 children to walk home from church. You MUST send permission to your child's class teacher for this.


#### **ALL PARENTS / CARERS**
