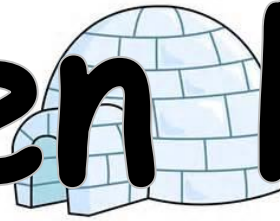
Music will be taught by Mrs Clewes.

The children will continue to familiarise themselves with Purple Mash and will design their own Rainbow animal. We will continue to focus on word processing skills.



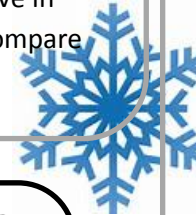
The children will learn about the Church and why it is a special place for Christians. They will learn the Christmas story.
